**Summary:** Retirement System and Pensions, S.C.; errors, certification and correction; Police Officers, General Assembly

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 9-1-1670, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE EFFECT OF AN ERROR IN RECORDS OF THE STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR CORRECTION OF AN ERROR WITHIN TWO YEARS OF ITS COMMISSION UPON WRITTEN CERTIFICATION OF THE ERROR AND CORRECTION OF ITS RECORDS BY THE EMPLOYER, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE TWO-YEAR LIMIT DOES NOT APPLY TO PENDING REQUESTS FOR CORRECTION; TO AMEND SECTION 9-4-40, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SO AS TO CHANGE THE RETIREMENT AGE TO SIXTY-TWO FROM SIXTY-FIVE FOR A MEMBER CURRENTLY EMPLOYED BY A CORRELATED SYSTEM; TO AMEND SECTION 9-11-10, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO DEFINITIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE POLICE OFFICERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A "POLICE OFFICER" INCLUDES A PEACE OFFICER EMPLOYED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS OR THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE POLICE OFFICERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM APPLIES TO POLICE OFFICERS AS SO DEFINED; AND TO AMEND SECTION 24-1-280, RELATING TO PEACE OFFICERS, SO AS TO INCLUDE EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE.-AMENDED TITLE
