Summary: Hunting and fishing licenses

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 50-9-20, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE DURATION OF HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ANNUAL HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES ARE VALID FOR ONE CALENDAR YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE RATHER THAN THE CURRENT STATE FISCAL YEAR LICENSE PERIOD AND TO IMPOSE A ONE DOLLAR SURCHARGE ON HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES AND PERMIT FEES FOR LICENSES AND PERMITS ISSUED BEGINNING JULY 1, 2004, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2009, AND TO REQUIRE THE REVENUE OF THE SURCHARGE TO BE CREDITED TO A SEPARATE FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY, THE REVENUE OF WHICH MUST BE APPROPRIATED ANNUALLY TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO MODERNIZE THE DEPARTMENT'S COMPUTER CAPABILITIES.
