Summary: Jobs tax credit

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-6-3360, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE TARGETED JOBS TAX CREDIT, SO AS TO ALLOW THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE AND PER CAPITA INCOME FACTORS TO BE CALCULATED FOR AN INDIVIDUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT LOCATED IN A COUNTY DESIGNATED DEVELOPED OR MODERATELY DEVELOPED AND IF THOSE FACTORS IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FALL WITHIN THE RANGE OF A DISTRESSED, LEAST DEVELOPED, OR UNDERDEVELOPED COUNTY, TO ALLOW A PROJECT LOCATED IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO RECEIVE THE CREDITS ALLOWED IN A DISTRESSED, LEAST DEVELOPED, OR UNDERDEVELOPED COUNTY, AS APPLICABLE, IF THE PROJECT IS OTHERWISE QUALIFIED, JOB DEVELOPMENT CREDITS.
