Summary: Contractors

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 40-11-200, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO UNLAWFUL PRACTICES AND PENALTIES IN REGARD TO CONTRACTORS, SO AS TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO FALSELY AND DECEITFULLY OBTAIN MONEY OR OTHER THINGS OF VALUE FROM ANOTHER PERSON WITH INTENT TO DEFRAUD THAT PERSON WHEN OFFERING TO PERFORM SERVICES AS A CONTRACTOR AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; TO AMEND SECTION 40-11-370, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE UNLAWFUL USE OF THE TERM "LICENSED CONTRACTOR", SO AS TO LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF THE CONTRACT PRICE A LICENSED CONTRACTOR MAY RECEIVE BEFORE CONSTRUCTION BEGINS AND TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS.
