A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 7-11-15, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE PROCEDURE FOR A CANDIDATE TO FILE AND RUN FOR PARTISAN OFFICES IN A PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTION, SO AS TO ALLOW THE GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY TO TRANSFER ALL RESPONSIBILITIES FOR CANDIDATE FILING AND QUALIFICATION FROM THE RESPECTIVE COUNTY PARTY CHAIRMEN OR COUNTY EXECUTIVE PARTY COMMITTEES TO THE AUTHORITY CHARGED BY LAW WITH CONDUCTING THE ELECTION.
