A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 4, TITLE 30, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, BY ADDING ARTICLE 3 SO AS TO ENACT THE "PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION PROTECTION ACT" AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT BY STATE AGENCIES OF PROCESSES AND PROCEDURES THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR REASONABLY MAINTAINING THE PRIVACY OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION; AND TO REDESIGNATE THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT AS ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE 30.
