Summary: Constitutional Amendment proposed relating to dual office holding

A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 24 OF ARTICLE III, SECTION 3 OF ARTICLE VI, AND SECTION 1A OF ARTICLE XVII OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, ALL RELATING TO DUAL OFFICE HOLDING AND QUALIFICATION FOR OFFICE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE PROHIBITION AGAINST HOLDING TWO OFFICES OF HONOR OR PROFIT DOES NOT APPLY TO COMMISSIONED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, CORRECTIONS OFFICERS, OR DEPUTY CORONERS WHO HOLD PUBLIC OFFICE IN A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OTHER THAN THE ONE IN WHICH THEY SERVE AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, CORRECTIONS OFFICER, OR DEPUTY CORONER.
