### **S 0072 General Bill, By McConnell and Hayes**

A Bill to amend Section 20-3-10, Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, relating to grounds for divorce, so as to provide that a husband and wife living separate and apart without cohabitation for a period of one year means a voluntary or involuntary separation.
