Summary: Traffic offenses

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 56-7-90 SO AS TO PROHIBIT A MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FROM REQUIRING OR REQUESTING THAT A PERSON CHARGED BY THAT OFFICER WITH A TRAFFIC OFFENSE PROVIDE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER; AND TO AMEND SECTION 12-56-20, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO DEFINITIONS, INCLUDING THE DEFINITION OF "DELINQUENT DEBT" FOR PURPOSES OF THE SETOFF DEBT COLLECTION ACT, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A DELINQUENT DEBT DOES NOT INCLUDE A FINE, ASSESSMENT, AND COSTS RESULTING FROM CONVICTION OF A TRAFFIC OFFENSE IN MUNICIPAL COURT.
