### **S\*0736 (Rat #0208, Act #0158 of 2005) General Bill, By Ryberg and Peeler**

**Summary:** Vietnam War Veterans' special license plates

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-7780, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF "VIETNAM WAR VETERANS" SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ONLY VIETNAM WAR VETERANS WHO SERVED ON ACTIVE DUTY AT ANYTIME DURING THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY 28, 1961 TO MAY 7, 1975, AND WHO CAN PROVIDE CERTAIN OFFICIAL DOCUMENTATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES THAT VERIFIES THEIR SERVICE MAY BE ISSUED THIS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-8800, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF WORLD WAR II VETERANS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO DELETE THE PROVISION THAT REQUIRES THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES RECEIVES A CERTAIN NUMBER OF PREPAID APPLICATIONS FOR THIS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE OR A DEPOSIT FROM THE INDIVIDUAL OR ORGANIZATION SEEKING THE ISSUANCE OF THIS LICENSE PLATE AND A PLAN TO MARKET THE SALE OF THIS LICENSE PLATE BEFORE IT PRODUCES AND DISTRIBUTES THIS LICENSE PLATE, AND THE PROVISION THAT REQUIRES THE DEPARTMENT NOT TO PRODUCE ADDITIONAL LICENSE PLATES IN THIS SERIES IF IT RECEIVES LESS THAN THREE HUNDRED BIENNIAL INITIAL OR RENEWAL APPLICATIONS FOR THIS LICENSE PLATE; TO AMEND CHAPTER 3, TITLE 56, BY ADDING ARTICLE 56 SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF UNITED STATES ARMED SERVICES SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-9600, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF "NO MORE HOMELESS PETS" SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO SUBSTITUTE THE TERM "SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE" FOR THE TERM "STATE VETERINARIAN". - ratified title
