Summary: State health insurance, disabled law enforcement officer eligible; Public employees, administrative paid leave when

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 1-11-730, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PERSONS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN STATE INSURANCE PLANS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY AN ENTITY WHOSE EMPLOYEES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR STATE INSURANCE PLANS WHO ARE PERMANENTLY DISABLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY AND WHOSE EMPLOYMENT IS TERMINATED AS A RESULT OF THE DISABILITY ARE ELIGIBLE FOR STATE HEALTH AND DENTAL INSURANCE PLANS AND STATE PAID PREMIUMS; AND TO AMEND SECTION 8-11-40, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO SICK LEAVE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT PERMANENT FULL-TIME STATE EMPLOYEES AND LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS WHO ARE TEMPORARILY DISABLED AS A RESULT OF AN ASSAULT ARISING OUT OF AND IN THE COURSE OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT MUST BE PLACED ON ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE WITH PAY BY THEIR EMPLOYER RATHER THAN SICK LEAVE.
