Summary: Elector who votes in partisan primary prevented from signing a petition for candidate to run against the winner

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 7-13-37 SO AS TO PROHIBIT AN ELECTOR WHO VOTES IN A PARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTION FROM SIGNING A PETITION FOR A CANDIDATE TO RUN AGAINST THE WINNER OF THE PARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTION.
