A BILL TO AMEND SECTIONS 27-37-20 AND 27-37-40, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO EJECTMENT PROCEEDINGS AGAINST A TENANT, SO AS TO GIVE A TENANT FIVE DAYS, RATHER THAN TEN DAYS, TO SHOW CAUSE WHY HE SHOULD NOT BE EJECTED; TO AMEND SECTION 27-37-160, RELATING TO EXECUTION OF WRIT OF EJECTMENT, SO AS TO ALLOW A CONSTABLE OR DEPUTY SHERIFF TO EFFECTUATE EJECTMENT EVEN IF HE HAS LEFT THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE TENANT IN THE DWELLING TO PROTECT IT FROM INCLEMENT WEATHER OR OTHER FORCES; AND TO MAKE GRAMMATICAL CHANGES.
