A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 17-27-20 OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PERSONS WHO MAY INSTITUTE A POST-CONVICTION RELIEF PROCEEDING, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON MAY INSTITUTE A POST-CONVICTION RELIEF PROCEEDING IF THE PERSON HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF AND SENTENCED FOR A CRIME.
