A Bill to amend Title 24, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Chapter 22 so as to establish an Offender Management System Act to alleviate prison overcrowding by providing for the identification, preparation, and placement of appropriate nonviolent offenders in the community; and to repeal Sections 24-3-1110 through 24-3-2060 (Article 11 of Title 24), The Prison Overcrowding Powers Act.-amended title
