A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to Section 1, Article VI of the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, relating to the qualifications for a person elected to an office in this State or its political subdivisions, so as to require that each person must be an elector of the area he seeks to represent at the time he files for election to the office.
