A Bill to amend Chapter 15, Title 41, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 41-15-615 so as to provide that individuals, corporations, partnerships, or other business entities are not required to be represented by an attorney when appearing in a proceeding before the South Carolina Occupational Health and Safety Review Board, but may appear pro se.-amended title
