

**AGENCY’S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS**

The University of South Carolina Union publishes the approved mission statement at <http://uscunion.sc.edu/about/mission.html>. *In fall 2013, the campus created an abbreviated mission statement: The University of South Carolina Union is dedicated to providing a high-quality, competitive higher education that will enable students to thrive in a global, diverse, and constantly changing environment. By providing a varied curriculum, grounded in the Liberal Arts, USC Union emphasizes a close working relationship among students, faculty, staff, and the community that promotes self-reliance, freedom of thought and expression, productive citizenship, and critical thinking.*

**USC Union Goal 1: Increase Enrollment and Retention**

Student enrollment, in terms of headcount, decreased in 2015-2016 from 679 in fall 2014 to 569 in fall 2015. However, spring 2016 enrollment was up to 762, which was the highest enrollment ever at USC Union, bolstered by the Pacer Pathway with USC Aiken and increased dual enrollment offerings.

In efforts to build on that momentum and further increase enrollment heading into the fall 2016 semester, we have further supported the Pacer Pathway program, added two new dual enrollment locations, and enhanced our marketing efforts to recruit more new full-time freshmen on campus in Union and at Laurens, including students who have interacted with us already via dual enrollment courses. An example of the success of these efforts includes the largest on campus recruiting event ever at USC Union, when over 100 of our dual enrollment high school juniors and seniors attended our USC Union Scholars of Excellence Program for spring 2016. That represents well over a 100% increase in attendance over the best turnout from previous years. We also have attracted a number of new students by reinstating our Club Baseball team for the 2016-2017 academic year, and adding Softball as well. Both of which are in the process of applying to enter into a Junior College athletic conference. Union and Laurens counties have also implemented a scholarship program for new freshmen having graduated from county high schools, which will allow many of those students to attend our campuses tuition free. All of these changes have been featured in enhanced marketing efforts in the surrounding area, including radio and newspaper ads, and ads on digital billboards as far out as in Spartanburg, which have all been received positively.

As we move forward, we look forward to partnering with USC Upstate on a BSN program on our Union campus, which will significantly enhance our recruiting efforts of full-time freshmen on campus. And we also look forward to adding additional sports teams in the coming years, as well as creating student housing opportunities to assist in recruiting students from out of county and out of state, which has already begun to happen with some of our new baseball/softball student athletes. Taken together, enrollment is looking to once again increase to a new record high in Fall 2016, with current preliminary headcount already at 845.

Retention rates have remained flat for the 2010 (57.3%) and 2011 (58.0%) cohorts, although the latter represents the highest rate among all of the Palmetto College campuses. A number of strategies are being implemented to increase this rate further moving forward. The completion of the newly renovated Student Academic Success Center is a major component of those plans, as it will be open and staffed with tutors in a range of subjects, as well as provide the opportunity for students to utilize the new BrainFuse online tutoring options with technical assistance from Center staff. The Success Center will also help retain students by actively hosting a variety of workshops and events for students, including academic and career workshops. Retention will also benefit from additional training of academic advisors, our new dedicated Disability Services director, multiple sports teams, and the likely arrival of a BSN program to Union in partnership with USC Upstate. Not

only will this help in retaining on-campus full-time freshmen into their sophomore year, but it will also help in retaining dual enrollment students from their junior/senior year of high school, into conversion to a full-time freshmen on campus after graduating high school. Finally, the success of the Pacer Pathway program with USC Aiken will additionally result in an increase in the number of Associates degrees that we grant, as those students fulfill requirements for our Associates degree in route to admission as full-time upperclassmen at USC Aiken.

***USC Union Goal 2: Expand Academic Offerings***

A search for an English faculty member was successful in spring 2016, adding a new tenure-track member to the Union faculty. New full-time faculty searches in the coming 2016-2017 year will likely include nursing, natural science, criminal justice, and/or economics faculty. New course offerings have been made available by faculty as well, including some who were awarded course development grants from Palmetto College for the conversion of courses into online formats. During the 2016-2017 year, two faculty are applying for tenure and promotion to Associate Professor, and two faculty are undergoing their Third Year Reviews.

New course offerings have also been made available through the hiring of some new adjunct faculty, teaching classes that have not been available in person on the Union campus in a number of years (if ever), including EDTE 201, MSCI 210/210L, and ACCT 225/226.

As detailed in the most recent campus Blueprint, USC Union faculty reported producing 8 presentations, 3 publications, and 7 successful grants during the FY 2015-2016. Support of their scholarly work will continue to be available from Palmetto College and from the Union campus. The Union campus in particular will continue to support faculty travel to present their work, and will be instituting a new Research and Productive Scholarship fund to locally support faculty scholarly activity over the summer months.

***USC Union Goal 3: Enhance Educational Experience***

Full-time faculty at USC Union carry a normal teaching load of 12 contact hours per semester, with the opportunity for a course reduction to pursue scholarship over the academic year. In both domains, teaching and scholarship, faculty receive significant support from the campus and Palmetto College. A variety of teaching workshops, webinars, and trainings are made available to faculty throughout the year, in large part by the Center for Teaching Excellence in Columbia. Multiple grants are made available through Palmetto College for online course development. Faculty scholarship is supported by a healthy travel budget provided by the Union campus, allowing faculty to present their work at conferences all over the country. Starting this coming 2016-2017 year, in addition to the research grants already available from Columbia and Palmetto College, USC Union will initiate a local Research and Productive Scholarship grant program for our faculty as well. In supporting faculty in these ways, it helps to enhance the students' experiences in the classroom.

USC Union also supports USC's Graduation with Leadership Distinction (GLD) pathways. We have had two students earn this distinction over the past two years (spring 2014 and spring 2015), and continue to work with more students on pursuing that goal. GLD helps enhance students' educational experience by getting them to connect what they're learning in the classroom with meaningful experiences they're having outside of the classroom.

Finally, we also look to enhance students' educational experiences through increasing activities sponsored by the Success Center and the Student Government Association, as well as the Men and Women on a Mission and African American Association student organizations.

***USC Union Goal 4: Strengthen Infrastructure and Campus Resources***

- Main Building, Central Building, and Truluck Gymnasium professional cleaning of carpets and floors (complete);
- Main Building renovation/construction of Student Academic Success Center (complete)

- Construction of Student Center Courtyard (projected completion date unknown);
- Gazebo renovation (projected completion September 2016);
- Central Building window replacements (projected completion 06/2017);
- Central Building HVAC upgrades and retrofits (projected completion 06/2017);
- Central Building replacement of damaged fascia boards (projected completion 06/2017);
- Main Building interior plaster repairs and painting (projected completion 06/2017);
- Central Building and Main Building parking lot sealing, striping, and handicap additions (projected completion 06/2017);
- Main Building exterior wood repairs and painting (projected completion 12/2016);
- Main Building replacement of balcony posts and railings (projected completion 12/2016);
- Central Building carpeting for admissions area (projected completion 06/2017);
- Central Building entryway tile repairs (projected completion 12/2016).

***USC Union Goal 5: Strengthen Community Ties***

The campus hosts a wide variety of community events and activities each year. This includes annual events like the Upcountry Literary Festival, the National Chemistry Day activities, Miss USC Union pageant, walk for Alzheimers awareness, and youth summer camp. Moving forward, we will continue to be accessible to the community, including participating in events like the Uniquely Union Festival in fall 2016 and hosting local political debates.

We are also connected to the community through internships that our students take on as part of work-study assignments or as part of internships in fulfillment of degree requirements.

As our sports teams become more established they will also surely find new ways to engage with the community, as their home games are already being played on the fields of the Timken complex.

**A note about data availability**

Please note that for some performance measures, reports previously generated by the CHE were not available for FY15-16 actual values. The University of South Carolina transitioned student educational records to Banner, a comprehensive, fully integrated, graphical user-interfaced Student Information System. In that transition, there has been something of a data gap, whereby numbers previously generated one way are now being calculated in slightly different ways, for example, or in other cases where enrollment numbers are finalized at different points in the fiscal year now than they have been in previous years. As a result, in this transitional period, some data are not fully comparative. In other cases, reports are simply not available at the time of the submission of this Accountability Report, as is


