AGENCY'S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

THE SOUTH CAROLINA CONSERVATION BANK WAS ESTABLISHED IN 2002 AND FUNDING BEGAN IN 2004. DURING THIS TIME THE CONSERVATION BANK HAS CONSERVED, PRESERVED AND PROTECTED OVER 287,305 ACRES OF SIGNIFICANT NATURAL RESOURCE LANDS, WETLANDS, HISTORICAL PROPERTIES, PARKS AND ARCHEOLOGICAL SITES. THE AVERAGE COST IN CONSERVING THESE SIGNIFICANT LANDS AVERAGES \$525 PER ACRE AND \$.17 ON THE DOLLAR COMPARED TO THE FAIR MARKET VALUE. THE CONSERVATION BANK HAS PROVIDED FUNDING FOR NUMEROUS PROJECTS THROUGHOUT 45 OF THE 46 COUNTIES WITHIN THE STATE. THESE ACCOMPLISHMENTS HAVE BEEN REACHED THROUGH PARTNERSHIP EFFORTS BETWEEN THE CONSERVATION BANK AND NUMEROUS LAND TRUST ORGANIZATIONS. NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS. STATE AGENCIES AND PRIVATE CITIZENS.

THE FUNDING PROVIDED BY THE CONSERVATION BANK HAS HELPED CONSERVE THE FOLLOWING:
