<b>AGENCY MISSION</b>	<p>The primary mission of the University of South Carolina Columbia is the education of the state’s citizens through teaching, research, creative activity, and community engagement.</p> <p>Among America’s oldest and most comprehensive public universities, the University of South Carolina Columbia is the major research institution of the university system and its largest campus. At the heart of its mission lies the university’s responsibility to state and society to promote the dissemination of knowledge, cultural enrichment, and an enhanced quality of life.</p> <p>The University of South Carolina Columbia serves a diverse population of students with widely varying backgrounds, career goals, and levels of aspiration. The university offers over 320 degrees at the bachelor's, master's, doctoral, and professional program levels, affording students the most comprehensive array of educational programs in the state. Opportunities for personal and career development are provided to the citizens of South Carolina through outreach and continuing education activities. The university provides additional opportunities for associate degrees through Fort Jackson and through the oversight of regional Palmetto College campuses (Lancaster, Salkehatchie, Sumter, and Union).</p> <p>Through classroom and laboratory instruction delivered in a variety of face-to-face and distance learning formats and modalities, degree programs are offered in the following areas: arts and sciences; business; education; engineering and computing; hospitality, retail, and sport management; information and communications; law; medicine; music; nursing; pharmacy; public health; and social work. The depth and breadth of its graduate programs distinguishes the University of South Carolina Columbia from all other institutions of higher learning in South Carolina.</p> <p>Recognized by the Carnegie Foundation as a top research and community engaged institution, nationally ranked in start-up businesses, and conferring over 30% of all bachelor’s and graduate degrees awarded at public institutions in South Carolina, the university has a profound relevance, reach, and impact on the people of the state. As the flagship institution of the university system, the University of South Carolina Columbia leads the way in providing all students with the highest-quality education, including the knowledge, skills, and values necessary for success and responsible citizenship in a complex and changing world through engagement in nationally and internationally ranked research, scholarship, community outreach, and artistic creation.</p>

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## **AGENCY’S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS**

After his hiring as the 29th President of the University of South Carolina in August 2019, a new and broader approach to systematic, integrated, and system-wide planning and evaluation was initiated by new President, Robert (Bob) Caslen, Jr. As our world changes constantly — sometimes seemingly overnight — an agile university committed to properly serving its students, community and state well into the future must periodically reevaluate its priorities, opportunities and goals. It is in this light that a new strategic plan has been created to propel the University of South Carolina to future successes.

Building upon the foundation set by the Focus Carolina, the new Priorities expand areas of inclusiveness and improve ability for strategic planning to guide and evaluate a broader footprint of activity within the University that includes not just admitting more South Carolinians, but ensuring that they are academically prepared for higher education, that they can enter the University of South Carolina system at a place and time that is most convenient and affordable for them, that they can move within our system without barriers or challenges and that their academic training aligns with available job opportunities within our state and in an increasingly competitive global marketplace. Honoring its rich history and proud South Carolina home, the University of South Carolina Columbia is a public university that pursues excellence through eight strategic priorities:

- The best students
- World-class faculty and staff
- Outstanding Research
- Increase diversity
- Affordability and Accessibility
- Communities Partnerships
- Excellent Infrastructure
- Win with Character

The spring semester of 2020 was drastically impacted by the rapid spread of COVID-19. As a result of careful planning and well-thought-out decision making from leaders at both the state and university level, many services offered by the university were reimagined in ways where success is not captured by traditionally reported measures. We have learned how to pivot the entirety of our institution in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of our campus and community. We know that our students are adaptable to change and willing to push forward despite challenges. Our academic activity can continue to thrive, even if only virtually, while our world-class professors and instructors teach and coach their students at a distance. Our leading-edge research not only continues, but is a guiding effort in combating COVID-19 and bringing health and stability to our communities. Most of all, we know that the 219-year history of our university does not end in 2020: it truly grows stronger as the university continues to fulfill its flagship mission by simultaneously overcoming the challenges of the pandemic while also serving the needs of our students and community.

### **Focus Carolina**

The information below discusses the university’s success during the final year of Focus Carolina. Under the guidance of Focus Carolina, the University of South Carolina Columbia sought excellence in five areas: educating the thinkers and leaders of tomorrow; assembling and supporting a world class faculty; spurring innovation, creative expression, and community engagement; building inclusive and inspiring communities; and demanding institutional excellence. These strategic priorities supported the primary mission of the university: the education of the state’s citizens through teaching, research, creative activity, and community engagement.

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**Educate the Thinkers and Leaders of Tomorrow**

The strategies and objectives centered on the education of tomorrow’s leaders and thinkers focus on the achievement of measured growth of a highly competitive and diverse student population; the improvement of student retention and on-time graduation; the delivery of robust, relevant, innovative, and collaborative academic programs; and the encouragement of high-impact experiential learning. USC Columbia is committed to starting our students’ journey off strong with impactful orientation, a focused first year advising process and an award-winning freshman seminar. Our students will be primed for success by an increase in need- and merit-based scholarships; this funding will provide access via affordability to the world-class education offered in South Carolina’s capital city.

Leaders at USC Columbia recognize the challenges facing students when their college path takes longer than expected and USC Columbia is dedicated to improving freshman-to-sophomore retention rates, improving four- and six-year graduation rates, maximizing flexible student scheduling, and expanding living- learning communities. The abrupt transition to online courses during the spring 2020 semester could have put many students at risk for failing to return of graduate; however, due to the hard work and dedication of faculty, staff, and administrators, USC Columbia was able to maintain both its current freshman-sophomore retention rate and its 6-year graduation rate (88.6% and 77%, respectively).

Because a USC Columbia degree is more than just a piece of paper, the University is committed to delivering robust and relevant academic programs that will last our students a lifetime. Innovative and collaborative, our degree programs receive support from a strong general education program, the Carolina Core. Although general education assessment has long been a part of university culture, this goal has recently grown. USC has developed academic arenas that synergize our strengths across related academic programs, research, residential living/learning communities, and academic majors, giving students a path to related disciplines such as health sciences or computing, information and design. In years past, USC Columbia set itself apart with the development of the Graduation with Leadership Distinction program, encouraging students to engage in related in-class and outside-the-classroom activities and integrate those experiences in their senior year. In a second step, the plan will expand in a new focus on high-impact experiential learning that includes undergraduate research, internships, service learning, study abroad opportunities and peer mentor and leadership opportunities. All students will engage in at least one of these high impact experiential learning opportunities. USC wants its students prepared for life after college, and our commitment to student career readiness and graduate school placement includes over 2,900 students served by the Career Center during the 2019-20 academic year. Although the pandemic resulted in a lower number of engagements with the Career Center, our students continued to exceed expectations and, served well by a Carolina education, boasted a post-graduate employment/graduate school placement rate of nearly 80% despite these unprecedented times.

The University of South Carolina Columbia is also dedicated to learning excellence on the graduate level. Our commitment to excellence in graduate education includes an increase in scholarships and stipends, increased support for graduate student travel and collaborations, and increase in number of doctoral degrees conferred.

**Assemble and Support a World Class Faculty**

With just over 6,280 first-time, full-time freshmen enrolling in fall 2019, a world class faculty is an essential component to quality education. USC Columbia continues to maintain a low student to faculty ratio of 17:1, ensuring students receive quality, personalized attention and support. USC supports its faculty selection and retention efforts with a campaign to assess and improve faculty salaries to better align with national standards; the dedication of resources to attracting and retaining internationally recognized faculty; and the improvement of faculty mentoring opportunities and professional development. The New Faculty Academy is a year-long series of seminars designed to launch new faculty on a positive and productive trajectory. High-quality teaching

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is further encouraged via the Center for Teaching Excellence. The Center for Teaching Excellence stepped up to serve the Carolina community and increased enrollment in multiple workshops to over 16,000 during the 2019-2020 fiscal year—a growth of 30%. The Office of the Vice President for Research announced 279.4 million dollars in sponsored awards during the same period—a number that, while disproportionately affected by the difficult economic situation resulting from COVID-19, still exceeded last year’s amount.

**Spur Innovation, Creative Expression, and Community Engagement**

USC Columbia continues to increase its scholarly productivity and research. With faculty are nationally and internationally known for their research activity, USC continues to maintain the top ranking of the Carnegie Foundation as an institution with "Highest Research Activity" (R1). For the fourth year running, the University of South Carolina has set a new record for research activity and sponsored award funding, garnering 279.4 million in the 2019-2020 fiscal year and making a significant impact on the economy of the state.

USC Columbia is one of relatively few universities that has been awarded both the top Carnegie Research designation and the Carnegie Community Engagement designation. The University strives to give back to its community through both the education of its members—USC boasts a post-graduation employment rate of nearly 80%— and its many projects and programs. The University offers a variety of undergraduate service learning courses to develop service leaders during the college years. During the 2019-20 academic year, many service learning courses were cancelled due to COVID-19, resulting in a decrease of student enrollment. However, the university continues to offer innovative opportunities that allows students to engage while still maintaining appropriate social distancing measures required by COVID-19.

**Build Inclusive and Inspiring Communities**

USC Columbia strives to be a destination of choice for top faculty, students, and staff from a variety of backgrounds, races, cultures, and creeds. In order to recruit and retain high-achieving and high-quality faculty, staff, and students, the University recognizes that the quality of life on the University campus must be welcoming, inclusive, and encouraging. In addition to the development of programs that promote inclusion, USC Columbia strives to continue to increase its six-year graduation rate for under-represented minority students (71.7% for the 2013 cohort). The University is also committed to maintaining diversity on campus through the recruitment and retention of under-represented minority students, faculty, and staff. The University currently employs over 21.02% underrepresented minority faculty and 30% underrepresented staff, and increased its the percentage of under-represented minority students in its freshman class from 18.67% to 21.60% for Fall 2019.

**Achieve Recognized Institutional Excellence**

The University values the contributions made by those who work, teach, study, graduate, and learn at the institution and strives to recognize and show appreciation for those contributions and talents. The University is nationally and internationally recognized for numerous reasons, such as the number one undergraduate International Business major, number one International MBA program, one of the nation’s best Public University Honors Colleges, and one of the nation’s best first-year experience programs. One key metric includes the *US New and World Report* rankings, in which the University ranked 104. **Discussion**

USC Columbia’s reach across and impact within South Carolina is significant, and the University is proud of the students, faculty, and alumni who live and work here. Through its strategic planning process, the University has articulated a variety of valuable and measurable objectives that will help the University continue to remain a rich source of education, research, and service to the state and nation. The new strategic plan positions the

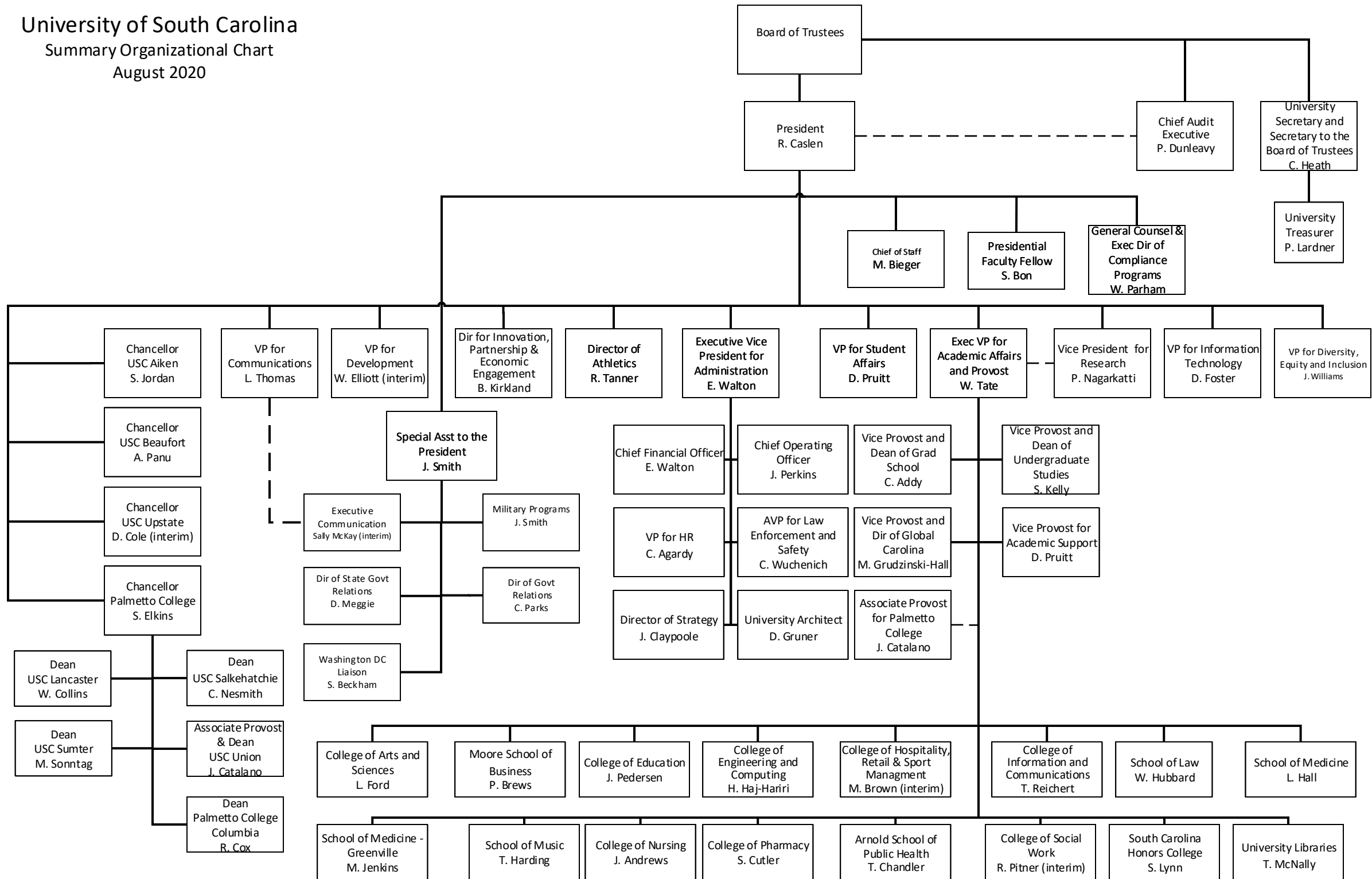
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university to expand its service to the citizens of South Carolina for years to come. If there is one constant for colleges and universities, it is that the higher education landscape is always changing. To be the best flagship university in the nation, South Carolina must serve the people of this state by evaluating this shifting landscape and making the necessary adjustments that produce leaders of character to meet the educational, professional, economic and corporate needs of this great state. In a world that is ever-changing, the University of South Carolina must continue to focus on the strategic horizon and be diligent both today and as we plan for the future. There are challenges ahead for higher education all over the country. But in its history, the University of South Carolina has perhaps never been so well-prepared to tackle the future and succeed.

**Risk Assessment and Mitigation Strategies:**

The Columbia campus has implemented a comprehensive Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) program which incorporates the fundamentals of risk identification, risk assessment, risk treatment, risk monitoring and review. The University has established this process using the guidance of International Standards Organization (ISO) 31000-2018 “Risk Management - Principals and Guidelines”. ISO provides the principles, framework and process for managing any form of risk in a systematic, transparent and credible manner. The ERM program operates within an established University ERM committee structure to provide a detailed picture of high priority risk areas as identified by upper management. This collaborative approach promotes a robust ERM process, improves the University’s risk management culture, provides a comprehensive view of risks, and enhances risk identification, prioritization and monitoring.
