University of South Carolina Beaufort Mission

The University of South Carolina Beaufort (USCB) responds to regional needs, draws upon regional strengths, and prepares graduates to contribute locally, nationally, and internationally with its focus on teaching, research, and service. USCB is a public, comprehensive institution in the University of South Carolina system, offering associate and baccalaureate degrees in the liberal arts, the sciences, and professional disciplines and select master's degrees in response to regional demand through on-site and distance delivery methods. Serving a diverse population, USCB enriches the quality of life for students and area residents through artistic and cultural offerings; collaborations with regional, national, and international partners; and lifelong learning opportunities.

As evidenced in its mission, the University of South Carolina Beaufort (USCB) is inextricably connected with the SC Lowcountry. As a product of an educational tradition dating back to 1795, USCB is steeped in history while serving as a cultural hub for the southern lowcountry, bringing together people from disparate backgrounds, both residents and tourists, for cultural and educational experiences from athletics and the arts to lifelong learning.

While USCB seeks to enrich the quality of life for lowcountry residents, the University is also shaped by its lowcountry setting. USCB is geographically and philosophically lowcountry, where people come together to support each other in difficult times and care for each other in their times of need.

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This *culture of caring* is part of what makes USCB uniquely warm and welcoming. USCB celebrates accomplishments—both its own and those of the community outside the institution's footprints.

COVID-19 chipped away at this culture, and it impacted so many aspects of life. With the requirements of remote work and social distancing, individuals necessarily became physically and emotionally separated. Without the face-to-face interpersonal connections, the small acts of kindness, the friendly pats on the back, many institutions, including USCB, saw the erosion of their people-centric culture. Some institutions are grateful for the increased savings as employees have transitioned to long-term work from home arrangements, while others have capitalized on the potential of increasing enrollments in online programs.

The *culture of caring* is an aspect of USCB that the institution is not willing to negotiate. The University and the community all benefit from the sense of camaraderie and kindness, and USCB is redoubling its efforts as an integral part of the lowcountry community. In the past year, USCB's Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) has increased its membership by 23% and contact hours by more than 10%. Through the University's SACSCOC Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP), *Students Connected*, USCB students have contributed more than 20,000 hours of experiential learning service in the region further cementing the important role the university plays in the community.

In Fall 2021, an Office of Academic Innovation was created to ensure that USCB is on the cutting edge of academic programming and institutional advancements to serve students and the community. USCB's first Center for Teaching and Learning was created and a director hired to provide an avenue for continued development of pedagogy and best practices to ensure students are receiving a top notch education undergirded by a caring and supportive community. A new degree program, BA in Public Health, was approved to provide another avenue for graduates to have an impact on the

Fiscal Year 2022

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community well beyond graduation. A concentration in Cybersecurity in the Information Science and Technology (ISAT) major began in Fall 2021 to fill the needs in this in-demand high tech field. Additionally, minors in Innovation and Entrepreneurial Studies and Event Management were created and implemented.

USCB and community partners have also continued to advance and improve technology and other infrastructure while maintaining a focus on people and place. Information Technology Support Services has made significant investments to ensure that all USCB employees and students have the technology they need to be the best in their areas of expertise.

As a result of USCB's ongoing commitment to caring for its students and its community, external funding for academics has tripled to \$3.3 million, including funding from the Town of Bluffton, the City of Beaufort, and Beaufort Country. The City of Beaufort is providing \$185,000 to upgrade the seating in the Center for the Arts on the Beaufort campus—the regions primary performing arts venue. USCB is also engaged in a partnership with the City of Beaufort to house the new ISAT Cybersecurity concentration in a 24,000 square foot state-of-the-art facility at 1100 Boundary Street on the Beaufort campus.

Funding has also been provided for many initiatives that have significant impact both locally and national. USCB researchers are investigating the health of coastal waterways, water quality and bacterial source tracking. Expertise is provided in cybersecurity education, sustaining Gullah Geechee agro-culture, Reconstruction era education, and math camps for under-served high school students. USCB researchers are having a national and even global impact through antibiotic research from shark microbe communities and research into energy-efficient high performance computing.

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
The residents of the lowcountry are aware of the impact USCB has on the community, and they are willing to make previously unheard of contributions to the University to ensure the impact of USCB's caring for the well-being of the community continues. In 2021/22, USCB raised in excess of \$1 million. This includes providing \$38,500 to fund a makerspace on the Bluffton campus where students and faculty can come together with the latest technology to develop products in support of educational goals. The community has also been a key supporter of USCB Athletics' move from the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) to the NCAA Division II Peach Belt Conference in Fall 2022. This move, along with the concurrent addition of basketball to the sports roster, will provide even more engagement with the community and additional safe recreational opportunities for lowcountry residents.

Perhaps one of the most significant result of USCB's commitment to its *culture of caring* is the impact it has had on enrollment during the ongoing downturn related to COVID-19. Fall 2021 enrollment at USCB was up more than 1.5% over Fall 2020, and USCB was the only four-year campus of the UofSC system that experienced growth. Fall 2022 promises even more increases, with a projected increase in new freshmen enrollment of more than 10% and more than 3% increase in overall enrollment.

USCB's *culture of caring* is clearly having a positive impact on the institution, its students, and the lowcountry. USCB is committed to fostering this culture beyond pre-COVID levels because this is one of the defining characteristics of the institutions, and a feature that endears the SC Lowcountry to the University. Caring for and about each other—whether within the institution, in the SC Lowcountry community, or beyond—is one of many aspects that makes being a USCB Sand Shark a luxury rather than a responsibility.
