### **AGENCY'S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS**

USC Salkehatchie is a dynamic regional campus serving the rural Lowcountry. Indeed, USC Salkehatchie was recently recognized by Niche as one of the top 5 Best Community Colleges in South Carolina. However, there is always more to do. The University is one of the anchors in the community and a key for future growth and prosperity in a region characterized by widespread poverty and a declining population. Despite challenges inherent to its region's economic conditions, USC Salkehatchie successfully strives to meet lofty goals. In line with the flagship's Path to Excellence strategic plan, USC Salkehatchie has continually sought excellence in **student population and success; faculty efforts in the classroom and in research; diversity and inclusion; affordability and accessibility; community partnerships; organizational/financial health; and athletic success.** 

Prior to the analysis of goals, it must be noted that during the 2020–21 fiscal year, various aspects of USC Salkehatchie's operations were negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite the additional challenges that affected performance metrics, Salkehatchie has continued to meet the needs of its students and its communities.

### The Best Students/Affordability and Accessibility

Despite the challenges that accompany the region's economic conditions and declining populations, USC Salkehatchie's student body has held steady, with the total numbers for headcount and full-time enrollment changing only slightly from the end of the first decade of the 2000s to the present. Such stability despite considerable headwinds is attributable to program expansions in athletics and academics and to aggressive recruiting, which has enabled the institution to attract a larger percentage of a shrinking market. Enrollment growth is both a short-term and long-term focus for USC Salkehatchie, and the move toward a larger student body is balanced with a desire to recruit and retain students committed to learning. USC Salkehatchie serves as an alternate access point to higher education for students whose situations—whether economic, personal, or academic—will not allow them to begin immediately at a four-year campus. USC Salkehatchie's tuition and required fees are tied with the other Palmetto College campuses as the lowest financial threshold to a university education in the state, and tuition and required fees were not raised last year. At USC Salkehatchie's 2021 Commencement, 79 A.A. or A.S. degrees were awarded to students. Furthermore, the expansion of academic offerings through Palmetto College is enabling Salkehatchie to serve more students locally for longer. While many students pursue baccalaureate degrees at other institutions after completing the first two years of higher education at Salkehatchie, many others are now taking advantage of collaborative programs in nursing and education, as well as Palmetto College online classes, to complete the requirements for baccalaureate degrees without having to leave the Salkehatchie area. USC Salkehatchie's 2021 Commencement included the awarding of 32 four-year degrees through its partnerships. Moreover, for the sixth year in a row, USC Salkehatchie nursing graduates earned a 100% NCLEX first-time pass rate (the national pass rate is 88.09%). All of the above numbers represent students taking advantage of lifechanging opportunities. The expansion of academic offerings is essential for the achievement of Salkehatchie's mission as an institution of higher education. Indeed, Salkehatchie consistently strives to find new and innovative ways to fulfill students' long-term educational goals and meet the educational needs of its communities. This includes embracing USC's Graduation with Leadership Distinction (GLD) and overall expansion of experiential-learning opportunities, as well as Salkehatchie's longrunning efforts to form community and local-industry partnerships that facilitate/inspire student internship opportunities and career paths.

### World-Class Faculty/Staff and Outstanding Research

Salkehatchie also continues to emphasize faculty excellence by striving to offer competitive salaries; by providing opportunities for greater intellectual challenge through the teaching of upper-level courses in Palmetto College; Narrative FY 2020-2021 3 AGENCY NAME: USC Salkehatchie AGENCY CODE: H380 SECTION: 20F by providing support for engagement in scholarship and research; and by encouraging involvement in campus and local-community service. The greater University has shown support by making internal grant opportunities available to Palmetto College campuses faculty (as well as students for undergraduate research), and the Salkehatchie faculty has responded by regularly winning these grant awards, thereby enhancing their scholarly production/expertise in their fields. Overall, USC Salkehatchie faculty has been highly successful with scholarly production and grants. At the time of last report (mid Spring 2021), the faculty had over the previous year 20 scholarly publications, 23 presentations at scholarly conferences, and had successfully applied for 6 internal and external grant opportunities.

### **Increase Diversity**

USC Salkehatchie strives to attract faculty, staff, and students from a variety of backgrounds through a welcoming, inclusive, and encouraging campus culture. As a result of its service area, Salkehatchie's student population is approximately 50% African American, and numerous students of various backgrounds, races, cultures, and creeds attend Salkehatchie. The schools' athletic programs are a magnet for International students who further enrich the campus environment. Additionally, USC Salkehatchie seeks to recruit and retain faculty and staff from diverse backgrounds, especially underrepresented minorities, through targeted advertising and other methods.

### **Community Partnerships and Excellent Infrastructure**

Educational attainment is the cornerstone of USC Salkehatchie's mission, but community outreach efforts demonstrate the institution's creativity in meeting local needs. The Salkehatchie Leadership Institute, the community-outreach arm of the university, assists municipalities and community groups with economic development and other projects that strike directly at the quality of life experienced by the residents of the region. Among its many efforts, the Institute sponsors a Take Flight! Aviation Camp for 8th graders from Allendale County and Colleton County. Partnering with The Boeing Company, the local chapter of the Tuskegee Airmen, Joint Base Charleston and other local organizations, this camp provides the opportunity for youth in the service area to learn more about STEM fields and explore the aerospace opportunities in our region. This model camp has been recognized nationally as an innovative community partnership. Similarly, the Institute organizes a University of Possibilities outreach effort to promote college attendance to approximately one hundred area middle-school students. The Institute also provides leadership training and development for area high-school students and students participating in USC Salkehatchie student government, as well as providing a yearlong advanced leadership program for civic leaders residing in the six counties of Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Colleton, Hampton, and Jasper, sponsored by the local economic development alliance, SouthernCarolina Alliance. The Institute was instrumental in renovations made to the historic Carolina Theatre, accomplished in part through a USDA Rural Development grant, completed in 2013. Since that time, the theater has proved an important space for use by theater classes and has hosted numerous cultural and university events. Moreover, during the COVID-19 pandemic, the theater has been used as a standard classroom as it allows for greater social distancing than standard meeting spaces. Additionally, USC Salkehatchie was selected as a partner in an initiative by Savannah River Site with the Department of Energy for a WORC (Workforce Opportunities in Regional Careers) grant. Through this partnership

we have been able to focus our efforts on strengthening regional workforce pipeline development and promoting STEM career opportunities available through Salkehatchie, including our Associate of Science, the 2+2 Industrial Process Engineering program with USCA, and the Computer Science program (with an emphasis on Cybersecurity) through Palmetto College, while providing support to students through free peer tutoring, scholarships, individualized internships, experiential learning, and mentoring. This partnership and its Narrative FY 2020-2021 4 AGENCY NAME: USC Salkehatchie AGENCY CODE: H380 SECTION: 20F impacts extend beyond current USC Salkehatchie students, to K-12 students and community members throughout the service area. Hands-on STEM outreach events, led by our STEM Coordinator with support from current Salkehatchie STEM student ambassadors, expose and motivate participants, while simultaneously increasing awareness of the possibilities available regionally. USC Salkehatchie has played a significant role in the revitalization of the region in other ways too. Two initiatives that demonstrate the institution's commitment to regional improvement are "University Mile" and a community-based "college town" initiative. University Mile was a streetscape project for downtown Allendale developed with the town and SCDOT. USC Salkehatchie and other community partners brought this project to fruition, and work on this project was completed last year. USC Salkehatchie is also developing a "college town" approach to growth for both Allendale and Walterboro that has been embraced by both communities. Several years ago, USC Salkehatchie leaders worked with private developers, as well as the county and city, to build The Reserve, a student housing complex on property adjacent to the USC Salkehatchie West campus in Allendale. The facility, which opened in 2015, was ninety percent full during its first year of operation and since then consistently has been at or near capacity. A similar partnership for the Walterboro campus was recently launched with "Salk Place" and "Salk Manor" apartments for students in the downtown Walterboro area. Walterboro housing options continue to be explored. Within greater UofSC's "Experience by Design" quality enhancement program (administered by the Center for Integrative and Experiential Learning), USC Salkehatchie continues to support faculty members who involve students in internships, independent research, and other modalities of experiential learning. USC Salkehatchie seeks to increase the number of students involved in service learning and Graduation with Leadership Distinction (GLD) honors. Moreover, as discussed above, USC Salkehatchie now has a STEM coordinator who assists students with experiential learning and internship opportunities by working with the Savannah River Site and other industries. Salkehatchie continues to provide campus activities and programs that are designed to enrich the experience of its students and enhance its communities. To ensure institutional strength, stability, and excellence, USC Salkehatchie is constantly involved not only in systemwide planning, but also in its own long-range planning, work that traditionally occurs in Executive Council, especially during the Executive Council's fall, spring, and summer retreats. Recent achievements include setting aside and maintaining 3 months' operating budget in reserve; improvements to Allendale and Walterboro facilities, including a long-range plan for renovations that will add useful space to the Walterboro campus; the shuttering and planned demolition of Allendale facilities deemed financial and insurance liabilities; and the continued implementation of PeopleSoft in HR. USC Salkehatchie constantly revisits and enhances institutional planning processes, using assessment methods for continual improvement in administrative support services, including business-office operations, physical plant and maintenance, and university development.

### **Risk Assessment and Mitigation Strategies**

USC Salkehatchie participates in the UofSC Enterprise Risk Management Program (ERM), which was established with the guidance of International Standards Organization, ensuring that any and all forms of risk are managed in a systematic, transparent, and credible manner. Risk is routinely considered in long-and short-term institutional planning. USC Salkehatchie is the primary higher education institute in


Allendale County and Colleton County, along with our other service areas (Bamberg, Barnwell, and Hampton Counties), and failing to accomplish our goals and objectives would negatively impact the statewide enterprise objective to elevate the level of educational preparedness of South Carolinians.

The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus is a branch campus of the University of South Carolina Columbia. Salkehatchie has as its mission to provide higher education and intellectual leadership for its service area. At the heart of this mission is a teaching faculty of high quality dedicated to excellence in instruction, scholarship, public and professional service and creative endeavor which enrich the classroom experience. The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus offers a varied curriculum grounded in the liberal arts and focused on preparing students to continue their education in the University of South Carolina System and throughout life.

The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus recruits students prepared to succeed in completing a baccalaureate-level education. While the institution does not offer remedial instruction, it is nonetheless able to admit most students who apply due to the close working relationship between students and faculty. The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus was established to encourage higher education in the counties of Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Colleton and Hampton. The original design of the institution incorporated a flexibility that has allowed changes in institutional capability with increasing educational demands of constituents.

Through classroom and laboratory instruction delivered in a variety of face-to-face and distance learning formats and modalities, the institution awards the Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees and provides for the completion of selected bachelor's degrees on campus through cooperative agreements and delivery structures with other University of South Carolina System institutions. The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus also provides general education and upper division coursework applicable to baccalaureate degree programs offered through colleges and universities nationwide. In addition to academic coursework, the mission of the campus includes on credit courses, seminars, and workshops made available to the community for cultural enrichment and professional development.

The traditions of cultural diversity and freedom of thought are valued at the Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus. In a learning environment that develops respect for racial, geographical, intellectual, and economic diversity and an awareness of individual, societal, and global responsibilities, Salkehatchie promotes courses, activities, and attitudes which influence the life of the mind in men and women and instill in them a thirst to continue learning throughout life.

The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus emphasizes the development of the whole person and especially seeks to foster in students the disciplines essential to an educated citizenry. Core competencies, including the ability to communicate through effective writing and articulate speech; computational and quantitative mastery; creative and critical thinking; and the duties of citizenship are strategically integrated within the curriculum. Classroom experiences, student activities, and physical education programs also provide opportunities for cultural enrichment, leadership development, intellectual growth and interpersonal relationships, all contributing to a sense of self-reliance and a joy of learning.
