### **AGENCY'S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS**

Since 1801, the University of South Carolina Columbia has shared the goals, triumphs, and hardships of its state. Within the very name of our university rests its most solemn obligation: the obligation to the people of South Carolina. That includes not just admitting more South Carolinians but ensuring that they are academically prepared for higher education, that they can enter the University of South Carolina system at a place and time that is most convenient and affordable for them, that they can move within our system without barriers or challenges and that their academic training aligns with available job opportunities within our state and in an increasingly competitive global marketplace.

USC unveiled its most recent strategic plan, For South Carolina: A Path to Excellence, in 2020. This broad and ambitious plan was thoughtfully crafted by USC faculty, staff, and students during a critical juncture in higher education. The nation was in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic and higher education institutions across the country were dealing with a myriad of challenges related to funding and maintaining operations as usual, all while prioritizing the health and well-being of their community members. During this time, the USC community aligned on a strategic plan that articulated our mission and vision and a set of eight strategic priorities. USC's priority areas included cultivating the best students and world-class faculty and staff, fostering outstanding research and community partnerships, and other ambitious goals. This comprehensive strategic plan detailed a path forward and expressed our aims for the future, including 25 goals, 71 objectives, 185 programs, and 260 metrics. Since this plan was broad and applicable to so many facets of important work, it resonated with many of our dedicated community members.

In the last three years, our institution has welcomed new leadership, presenting an opportunity to sharpen our near-term strategic focus. Our leadership stands by and values the priorities included in the 2020 strategic plan and will continue to further our important work in those areas. Each priority reflects our foundational values of **Access and Transparency**, **Inclusive Excellence**, and **Service and Integrity**, which are also at the core of our Carolinian Creed.

The University of South Carolina Columbia is a globally recognized, high-impact research university dedicated to providing a superior student experience. South Carolina, one of the fastest-growing flagship universities in the nation, offers abundant opportunities for students to succeed, from cutting-edge research initiatives to highly personal student services, from top-ranked academic programs to top-ranked athletics teams.

#### **Vision for the Future**

If there is one constant for colleges and universities, it is that the higher education landscape is always changing. The primary responsibility of any university is serving its students. In a world that is ever-changing, the University of South Carolina Columbia must continue to focus on the strategic horizon and be diligent both today and as the institution plans for the future. To be the flagship university of South Carolina, the institution must serve the people of this state by evaluating this shifting landscape and making the necessary adjustments that produce leaders of character to meet the educational, professional, economic and corporate needs of this great state.

USC embarked on a process in Fall 2022 to elevate critical near-term focus areas. Together, we will educate and empower our undergraduate and graduate students, equipping them to be change makers for the public good and to become the next generation of global leaders. We will support and nurture our faculty and staff who are innovators in education, scholarship, and community engagement. We will commit to user-friendly

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infrastructure, ensuring that our resources and processes are accessible and practical for our university community. Continued progress in these three areas will enable USC to achieve greater impact than ever before.

The strategic priorities work has also been closely aligned with our Imagine Carolina listening sessions for USC students, faculty, and staff. The Imagine Carolina retreats, held in the 2022-23 academic year, were designed to hear directly from USC students, faculty, and staff about their experiences at the institution, and served as an opportunity to gather candid feedback related to potential opportunities for growth. The findings from the retreats served as critical inputs to the development of our strategic priorities.

#### **Mental Health and Wellness**

The University has directed an additional \$1 million to support mental health and wellness. The university's commitment to student health and well-being includes strengthening and expanding access to the university's comprehensive suite of services. These funds will increase access to 24/7 mental health services and add staff members to the interpersonal violence and ombuds offices, Student Disability Resource Center and the Student Outreach and Care Team, which together create a coordinated network of support for students.

#### **Critical Infrastructure**

Critical technology infrastructure upgrades are ongoing. Classroom, living space and Wi-Fi upgrades will improve wireless connectivity and technological infrastructure across key areas of campus. The University has invested \$3 million in classroom equipment upgrades and \$6.5 million in wireless network upgrades to enhance connectivity across campus. New equipment will support classroom teaching and learning, and wireless network upgrades will accommodate higher bandwidth and increased wireless capacity.

The University celebrated the opening of our expansive Campus Village residential community with space for more than 1,800 residents, plus academic support resources, gathering and study spaces, and retail shops. The University also has increased campus dining options that offer more seating, more variety, more options for people with specific food preferences or requirements, more hours of operation, and new locations – among them, The Pavilion at Campus Village, a 650-seat all-you-care-to-eat dining space, and The Halal Shack in Russell House, with authentic Middle Eastern street food.

#### **Academic Advising**

While the university has made significant strides in academic advising in recent years, there is more work to do. In 2015, USC established the University Advising Center (UAC) to improve first-year advising; upper-class advising has differed from college to college. Over the next two years, the Office of the Provost will transition undergraduate academic advising to a four-year, comprehensive advising model. The UAC will partner with colleges to begin the transition this summer and continue implementation in stages to ensure all students receive an excellent and equitable advising experience. The University will hire additional full-time professional academic advisors, support advisor training and development, and implement technology to support advising.

#### **World-class Faculty and Staff**

Under the leadership of the Office of the Provost, the University of South Carolina Columbia is committed to recruiting and retaining faculty who can transform the lives of our students and transform the world with their research and scholarship. The University is working to pair faculty with a diverse, dedicated staff who

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together with our faculty will produce and instill a shared culture of excellence for the University. With just over 6,500 first-time, full-time freshmen enrolling in fall 2022, a world class faculty is an essential component to quality education. USC Columbia strives to maintain a low student to faculty ratio of 18:1, ensuring students receive quality, personalized attention and support. USC supports its faculty selection and retention efforts with a campaign to assess and improve faculty salaries to better align with national standards; the dedication of resources to attracting and retaining internationally recognized faculty; and the improvement of faculty mentoring opportunities and professional development.

#### **Outstanding Research**

In fiscal year 2023, faculty garnered \$243 million in research and sponsored awards funding. The University launched a new grant writing program called Propel that focuses on intensive mentoring and workshops. This new initiative is geared toward early-career faculty researchers with small grants who are ready to go for large NIH or NSF grants. Participants receive nine months of intensive support through workshops, mentorship, peer feedback and editing assistance. Another initiative called the STAR program targets senior faculty researchers and provides insight into identifying, applying for and successfully managing major federal center grants.

#### **Affordability and Accessibility**

The university offers over 350 degrees at the bachelor's, master's, doctoral, and professional program levels, affording students the most comprehensive array of educational programs in the state. Opportunities for personal and career development are provided to the citizens of South Carolina through outreach and continuing education activities. The university provides additional opportunities for associate degrees through Fort Jackson and through the oversight of regional Palmetto College campuses (Lancaster, Salkehatchie, Sumter, and Union).

Through classroom and laboratory instruction delivered in a variety of face-to-face and distance learning formats and modalities, degree programs are offered in the following areas: arts and sciences; business; education; engineering and computing; hospitality, retail, and sport management; information and communications; law; medicine; music; nursing; pharmacy; public health; and social work. The depth and breadth of its graduate programs distinguishes the University of South Carolina Columbia from all other institutions of higher learning in South Carolina.

#### **Community Partnerships**

The University is a major economic driver for the Palmetto State. The University of South Carolina Columbia offers Columbia a major competitive asset that has the potential to significantly boost growth throughout the next decade and beyond – namely, the presence of a high-skilled workforce. This implies that the University's total economic impact in the Midlands has the potential to increase substantially in the coming decade. The total annual economic impact of the University on the Columbia metropolitan region is approximately \$3.7 billion. This figure reflects the dollar volume of all economic activity that can be attributed to – directly or indirectly – the University of South Carolina Columbia. This includes increases in alumni wages that are earned and spent in the local community, ongoing business activities resulting from non-state funded expenditures, and all activities associated with university athletics.

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
The University of South Carolina Columbia contributes \$1.7 billion towards personal income and supports approximately 43,876 jobs in the Midlands community, 13,705 of which represent employees working directly at the institution. These estimates imply that the University supports approximately 1 in every 9 jobs in the Columbia metropolitan region.

The university's uniquely large contribution to Columbia's economy puts it in a position to take a leadership role in developing a strategy that Columbia can implement in the coming years in order to boost its rate of long-run economic growth. Such a strategy will be critical as the region recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic, especially considering that over the past decade Columbia's growth rate has lagged almost all other metropolitan regions of comparable size in the Southeast.

#### **Risk Assessment and Mitigation Strategies**

The University has implemented a comprehensive Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) program which incorporates the fundamentals of risk identification, risk assessment, risk treatment, risk monitoring and review. The University has established this process using the guidance of International Standards Organization (ISO) 31000-2018 "Risk Management - Principals and Guidelines". ISO provides the principles, framework and process for managing any form of risk in a systematic, transparent and credible manner. The ERM program operates within an established University ERM committee structure to provide a detailed picture of high priority risk areas as identified by upper management. Identified high priority risk areas include: governance, legislative relations, economic decline, emergency planning, disaster recovery, business continuity, laboratory safety, student safety, crime prevention, title IX compliance, data security and privacy, institutional data reporting, capital project management/deferred maintenance, enrollment management, personnel recruiting and retention/succession planning, research compliance, and IT system implementation. As necessary, the University monitors and tracks these high priority risk areas and implements actions plans to effectively control these risks.
