# **AGENCY'S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS**

Since 1801, the University of South Carolina Columbia has shared the goals, triumphs, and hardships of its state. Within the very name of our university rests its most solemn obligation: the obligation to the people of South Carolina. That includes not just admitting more South Carolinians but ensuring that they are academically prepared for higher education, that they can enter the University of South Carolina system at a place and time that is most convenient and affordable for them, that they can move within our system without barriers or challenges and that their academic training aligns with available job opportunities within our state and in an increasingly competitive global marketplace.

As the flagship institution of South Carolina's university system, USC has evolved into a network of eight distinct campuses: the main campus in Columbia, three regional comprehensive campuses (Aiken, Beaufort, and Upstate), and four regional two-year campuses (Lancaster, Salkehatchie, Sumter, and Union). In fall 2024, total headcount enrollment topped 56,000 students across all campuses. Columbia campus enrollment exceeded 38,000 students for the first time in the institution's history. Of the 7,259 first-time freshmen enrolled at USC Columbia for the fall 2024 semester, 3,800 (52%) are South Carolina residents - more South Carolinians than ever enrolled before. Students come from each of the state's 46 counties, as well as 47 U.S. states and 28 countries from across the world. Sixty-two percent are female, 27% are Historically Underrepresented Minorities (URM), 21% are Pell-eligible, and 20% are First Generation. Overall, on the Columbia campus, students are 60% female, 69% White, 10.4% Black or African American, and 6% Hispanic. USC is not just growing; it is setting new records. In addition to enrollment gains, USC reached a new high in sponsored research awards in 2024— \$309 million, an increase of 8% over the previous record. World-class USC researchers are addressing some of the most pressing issues through innovation, bolstering research areas such as cancer, Alzheimer's and stroke, and focusing on South Carolina's marine health. The university is a major center for global research, drawing students from around the world while also making higher education more accessible for South Carolinians.

In the last three years, our institution has welcomed new leadership, presenting an opportunity to sharpen our near-term strategic focus. Our leadership stands by and values the priorities included in the 2020 strategic plan and will continue to further our important work in those areas. Each priority reflects our foundational values of **Access and Transparency**, **Inclusive Excellence**, and **Service and Integrity**, which are also at the core of our Carolinian Creed.

The University of South Carolina Columbia is a globally recognized, high-impact research university dedicated to providing a superior student experience. South Carolina, one of the fastest-growing flagship universities in the nation, offers abundant opportunities for students to succeed, from cutting-edge research initiatives to highly personal student services, from top-ranked academic programs to top-ranked athletics teams.

The academic community comprises over 2,000 full-time faculty and 3,000 staff members who support over 350 degree programs across 16 colleges and schools. At USC Columbia, these faculty and staff are dedicated to not just creating a superior academic experience for students, but also to acting as partners in the Columbia community and South Carolina as a whole. University activity – the research, cultural events, teaching, tourism and more that occurs on and around campus -- is a key contributor to South Carolina's long-term economic and employment growth. More than simply providing jobs, the university's faculty, staff, students and alumni are forces equipped to drive generations of opportunity. The university has a \$7.4 billion annual impact on the state's economy and supports 61,700 jobs — 1 out of every 39 — statewide. In the Columbia metro region, the university supports 1 in 10 jobs, with a total annual economic impact of \$4.2

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billion. Moreover, two out of three alumni living in SC reside outside of the Columbia metro region, contributing to local economies across the state

### Vision for the Future

If there is one constant for colleges and universities, it is that the higher education landscape is always changing. The primary responsibility of any university is serving its students. In a world that is ever-changing, the University of South Carolina Columbia must continue to focus on the strategic horizon and be diligent both today and as the institution plans for the future. To be the flagship university of South Carolina, the institution must serve the people of this state by evaluating this shifting landscape and making the necessary adjustments that produce leaders of character to meet the educational, professional, economic and corporate needs of this great state.

Last year, the University of South Carolina introduced two major initiatives aimed at expanding access for South Carolina students. Both were launched with the incoming freshman class of Fall 2024. The first is a new admissions policy that guarantees acceptance to USC for South Carolina students who graduate in the top 10 percent of their high school class. Complementing this is the USC Commitment Grant, which ensures that tuition and academic fees are fully covered for top 10 percent students whose family income is below \$80,000. In the first year of implementation, these initiatives led to an increase in the number of top-performing South Carolina freshmen, including a notable rise in students from rural counties. These efforts reflect USC's ongoing commitment to making higher education more accessible and affordable for all South Carolinians.

At the same time, the university continues its efforts to reduce the financial burden of a college education for in-state students. Thanks to the most substantial funding support in recent memory from the South Carolina General Assembly, the institution has been able to maintain in-state tuition at the same level for the sixth consecutive year. When adjusted for inflation, this effectively amounts to a 25 percent reduction in the real cost of tuition over that period—demonstrating the university's strong commitment to affordability and access for South Carolina families.

# **First Generation**

The University of South Carolina has increased its collaboration with the <u>National Association of Student</u> <u>Personnel Administrators</u> to enhance support for first-generation students. As part of this initiative, USC has joined the NASPA First Scholars program, which will involve working alongside NASPA to identify and implement evidence-based changes to our existing processes and policies.

USC belongs to First Scholars cohort 5, which includes Florida State University, Texas Tech University, Texas State University, and the University of Wisconsin-Greenbay, among others. Sixty-five schools in total are participating in the First Scholars phase of the Network, although USC is the only public institution from South Carolina currently represented. Furman University and Presbyterian College are two past cohort members from the state.

This initiative to support first-generation students has the full backing of USC leadership. The work done through the <u>First Scholars Program</u> will build on USC's previous involvement in the NASPA First Gen Forward Program. Ultimately, these efforts aim to improve retention and graduation rates for all students.

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## **Increasing Student Access**

The University of South Carolina has joined the STARS College Network, a coalition of 32 of the nation's most prominent institutions dedicated to ensuring that students from rural and small-town America have the information and support they need to enroll and graduate from the college or university of their choice. STARS is made possible by the generosity and commitment of Trott Family Philanthropies, which will build on its initial launch gift of \$20 million with an additional investment of more than \$150 million over 10 years.

As one of the 16 new members, USC will combine its own resources with STARS philanthropy and collaborate with other STARS member institutions to support pipeline programs and recruiting efforts, as well as offer financial aid and on-campus programs to support students who enroll.

While students in small towns and rural communities graduate high school at roughly the same rate as students in metro areas, they are only half as likely to graduate from a selective college or university. USC aims to address some of the obstacles that contribute to this disparity through participation in the STARS College Network.

Small town and rural students face a shortage of school counselors, which limits access to educators and college access professionals who have experience with the full spectrum of college opportunities. Moreover, students in these areas are also less likely to encounter college-related ads or attend events on campuses, and many do not have the networks and resources to help them understand the financial aid process and other support available to them.

# **Academic Advising**

Beginning Fall 2024 the University Advising Center (UAC) for Academic and Post-Graduation Success implemented a university-wide professional staff four-year academic advising program for all undergraduate students. USC-Columbia employs 100 professional, full-time Academic Advisors assigned to students based on their major program of study. Caseloads are capped at no more than 300 students assigned to one advisor to allow for one-on-one meetings, outreach, intervention, and on-going support. This individualized approach enables all undergraduates to receive at least one guaranteed 30-minute appointment (with the ability to schedule more appointments as needed) to provide students holistic conversations related to curriculum, degree progression, experiential learning, and career readiness.

In addition to four-year professional advising, the UAC supports undergraduate student success through a wide variety of programs. The Office of Exploratory Advising and Academic Coaching advises ~5000+ students per year who transition from one of USC's baccalaureate colleges into another, provides coaching support to students on academic probation and students returning from academic suspension, and guides students exploring a new major or career. The UAC also provides faculty with curriculum support through curricular analytics tools and eight-semester major maps to promote clear degree pathways and promote timely graduation. Transfer students receive specialized advisement through dedicated advising staff who offer extended appointments, review degree applicability of transfer courses, and partner with the SC technical college system (notably Midlands Tech). Advisors also work with multiple student success technologies to provide accessible information, including Degree Works degree audit and MyUSCExperience co-curricular transcript.

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## **World-class Faculty and Staff**

Under the leadership of the Office of the Provost, the University of South Carolina Columbia is committed to recruiting and keeping faculty who can transform the lives of our students and transform the world with their research and scholarship. The University is working to pair faculty with a diverse, dedicated staff who together with our faculty will produce and instill a shared culture of excellence for the University. With just over 7,290 first-time, full-time freshmen enrolling in fall 2024, a world class faculty is an essential component to quality education. USC Columbia strives to maintain a low student to faculty ratio of 18:1, ensuring students receive quality, personalized attention and support. USC supports its faculty selection and retention efforts with a campaign to assess and improve faculty salaries to better align with national standards; the dedication of resources to attracting and keeping internationally recognized faculty; and the improvement of faculty mentoring opportunities and professional development.

# **Outstanding Research**

The University of South Carolina had an outstanding funding year in fiscal year 2024 (July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024), attracting \$309 million in grants and sponsored awards. This is a record high funding level for USC, but it's not the only milestone the university achieved. The University saw major increases over the previous fiscal year.

These numbers include over \$100 million in research awards from the National Institutes of Health and the Department of Health and Human Services, with projects focusing on artificial intelligence and bioinformatics, Alzheimer's and stroke, among other areas of study. Additional significant federal awards came from the National Science Foundation and the Departments of Defense and Commerce, focusing on areas such as biodegradable polymers, advanced manufacturing, energy systems for ships, semiconductor chips, and South Carolina's marine systems.

## Among the largest awards were:

- A \$3.5 million project, funded by the National Institute of Mental Health, focusing on "Emergence, Stability and Predictors of Anxiety in Fragile X Syndrome" and led by Professor Abigail Hogan in the Arnold School of Public Health. This award will continue a long-term developmental study that is investigating early predictors and features of anxiety in children with Fragile X Syndrome.
- A second example is a \$2.4 million award from the South Carolina Sea Grant Consortium/NOAA for a project led by William Strosnider at the Baruch Institute for Marine and Coastal Sciences. South Carolina's robust coastal economy relies on natural resource health to sustain water-quality protection, shoreline restoration and aquaculture. These services often rely on inexpensive plastic products to provide protection. The location of such materials in ecologically sensitive coastal environments creates a significant concern, so this grant will allow researchers to test the use of natural materials instead of these plastics, in order to protect the coast.
- One more example is a \$1.3 million award from NASA for a project led by engineering professor Paul Ziehl, focused on developing new thermoplastic composite materials that can be produced at a high rate for use in advanced aircraft. The next generation of aerospace systems requires materials and structures that are characterized by both high performance and also use in frequent, short missions.

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# **Affordability and Accessibility**

The University of South Carolina launched a new affordability initiative to cover tuition and academic fees on all system campuses for in-state students graduating in the top 10 percent of their high school class and whose family's annual household income is below \$80,000. The USC Commitment initiative, which will begin with the fall 2024 freshman class, follows an admissions plan unveiled in August offering guaranteed systemwide admission to South Carolina high school students who are ranked in the top 10 percent of their class for USC Columbia and in the top 20 percent for all other USC campuses. The program is made possible by combining state and federal gift aid, private donor and other external scholarships, and part of the recent funding provided from the Governor and members of General Assembly for tuition mitigation.

Last year, with financial backing from the State of South Carolina, the university launched the South Carolina Internship Program—an initiative that has proven to be a resounding success. The program provides \$3,000 stipends to students who complete internships in high-demand industries across the state, offering them valuable hands-on experience and a strong foundation for their future careers. These internships often lead directly to employment, as students frequently work with individuals who later become their employers. To date, the South Carolina Internship Program has awarded more than \$2.5 million in support, with 840 students successfully completing internships in high-demand industries across the state. Nearly 75 percent of participants have been South Carolina residents, and 20 percent have been first-generation college students. This initiative is not only enhancing career readiness for students but also strengthening the talent pipeline for key industries—helping retain graduates within the state and contributing to South Carolina's economic development.

# New Certificate Programs

President Michael Amiridis began his role as president of the University of South Carolina with an ambitious vision and hefty checklist of goals. One of his top priorities: ensuring that all students, regardless of major or class standing, would have the opportunity to graduate equipped with the skills to succeed in their future careers. During the last academic year, we fully launched four innovative interdisciplinary certificate programs to complement our students' degrees and make them more marketable with future employers. In the first cohort of participants, 460 students enrolled in these certificate programs to gain highly valued skills in four areas: digital studies; data analytics; project leadership and management; and strategic thinking and communications. And 100 students have already graduated with one of these certificates, enhancing their readiness for the job market.

# **Research Institutes**

The University of South Carolina will invest \$10 million over the next four years in five new interdisciplinary research institutes that will address some of the Palmetto State's biggest challenges, including health, education and water quality.

Each of the new research institutes will receive \$500,000 per year over four years from USC's Research Institutes Funding Program. The institutes will be led by multidisciplinary teams of research faculty focusing on innovative solutions to problems in South Carolina and beyond. Along with new breakthroughs, the institutes

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have the potential to bring future funding and prosperity to the state in the form of major federal grants and commercialization opportunities.

- The USC Institute for Rural Education and Development will seek better ways to teach math, science and engineering (STEM) to rural students across the state. Researchers will focus on early grades with an emphasis on developing a holistic approach to teaching STEM.
- The USC Institute for Extreme Semiconductor Chips will work to develop more powerful and efficient electronic and optical microchips which can be used for the electric grid, electric vehicles, aircraft and advanced health care applications. The development of homegrown computer chips also has been identified as an important national security priority.
- The USC Institute for Infections Disease Translation Research will study emerging diseases that have the potential to develop into major public health threats, especially those spread by insects and those transferred from mother to child.
- The USC Institute for Clean Water will explore novel ways to monitor water quality to ensure safe drinking water and to protect South Carolina's waterways for use by humans and wildlife alike.
- The USC Institute for Cardiovascular Disease Research will study the ways in which chronic stress leads to a host of physical ailments, including heart and kidney disease. The research could eventually lead to the development of new treatments for heart disease.

### **Risk Assessment and Mitigation Strategies**

The University has implemented a comprehensive Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) program which incorporates the fundamentals of risk identification, risk assessment, risk treatment, risk monitoring and review. The University has set up this process using the guidance of International Standards Organization (ISO) 31000-2018 "Risk Management - Principals and Guidelines". ISO provides the principles, framework and process for managing any form of risk in a systematic, transparent and credible manner. The ERM program works within an established University ERM committee structure to provide a detailed picture of high priority risk areasas identified by upper management. Identified high priority risk areas include: governance, legislative relations, economic decline, emergency planning, disaster recovery, business continuity, laboratory safety, student safety, crime prevention, title IX compliance, data security and privacy, institutional data reporting, capital project management/deferred maintenance, enrollment management, personnel recruiting and retention/succession planning, research compliance, and IT system implementation. As necessary, the University monitors and tracks these high priority risk areas and implements actions plans to effectively control these risks.

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
