**Fiscal Impact Summary**

**Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

**State Expenditure**

This bill amends Section 58-9-576, which states that for any local exchange carrier (LEC) that elected to operate under this subsection prior to January 1, 2016, the Public Service Commission may not regulate or impose requirements related to the terms, conditions, rates, or availability of any of the LECs stand-alone basic residential lines that were in service prior to the pre-election date. Also, this bill allows a customer to file a request for service through the Public Service Commission if the customer cannot receive voice service from any provider through any technology at the residence where the customer received a stand-alone basic residential line. The request for service expires four years after the effective date of this act.

**Public Service Commission.** The agency indicates that any expenses incurred as a result of this bill can be absorbed within current appropriations.
