Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill amends Section 44-1-60, by transferring the responsibility of adjudicating appeals of decisions made by the Department of Health & Environmental Control to the Administrative Law Court.

Department of Health & Environmental Control (DHEC). The Department reports that this bill would have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds. While the bill relieves the DHEC Board from the responsibility of adjudicating appeals of decisions of the Department, the agency would still have to prepare a defense of its decision when called before the Administrative Law Court in any contested decision. Preparation would involve the same time, research and review procedures as before.

Administrative Law Court. The Agency indicates that this bill will have no impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.


