Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill adds Section 24-13-180, which provides that any public, private, or nonprofit entity that is engaged in helping rehabilitate and reintroduce paroled prison inmates into the community and is a part of a program that provides residential housing to these parolees must provide notice in the community of the addresses where the residential housing facilities will be located. Additionally, a public hearing must be conducted regarding the program and the location of the residential housing facilities.


Local Expenditure
