Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill amends the certification requirements for law enforcement officers in Section 23-23-60(B) by adding that candidates for entry into the South Carolina Law Enforcement Academy will be required to pass a psychological examination. Should an officer's law enforcement certification lapse, the officer will be required to pass a subsequent psychological test prior to being reinstated.

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Training Council reports that this bill would have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
