**Fiscal Impact Summary**

**Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

**Introduced on January 10, 2017**

**State Expenditure**

This bill creates the Public Education Flexibility and Parity Study Committee (committee). This seven member committee must review information about programs and innovations in public education that might be adopted in some fashion by this state to improve parity in public schools. The committee will make a report of its recommendations to the General Assembly before January 31, 2018, at which time the committee will dissolve.

The committee will consist of three members from the House of Representatives, appointed by the Chairman of the House Committee on Education and Public works, three members from the Senate, appointed by the Chairman of the Senate Education Committee, and one member appointed by the Governor. At least one member from both the House of Representatives and the Senate must be selected based on the recommendation of the Minority Leader of the respective body. Each member will receive per diem of \$35, subsistence of \$195.53, and mileage for each meeting on non-session days. These expenses will be managed within the budgets of the appointees' respective legislative bodies. Additionally, the staffing for this committee will be provided by the House Committee on Education and Public Works and the Senate Education

Committee and will be managed with existing staff and within existing appropriations. Therefore, the bill does not have an expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds for the Senate or the House of Representatives.
