Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund or Other Funds for the Commission on Minority Affairs (the commission) since the activities that will be conducted by the commission are in the normal course of agency business and can be absorbed within existing resources.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on January 10, 2017

State Expenditure

This bill allows any Native American Indian Group that has been recognized by the Commission on Minority Affairs (the commission) prior to this bill becoming law to continue as such after the bill has been enacted. This bill requires the commission to eliminate the eligibility for any additional Native American Indian Groups or entities to receive official recognized status in South Carolina. The commission must also repeal any regulations providing recognition of Native American Indian Groups and revise regulations to remove the recognition procedure for a Native American Indian Group. This bill also requires the commission to revise its regulations to continue to provide for the privileges and obligations of Native American Indian Groups recognized by the commission before this bill becomes law.

The Commission on Minority Affairs. The commission indicates this bill requires the agency to perform activities that will be conducted in the normal course of agency business and can be absorbed within existing resources. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund or Other Funds.
