### **State Expenditure**

This bill authorizes auricular detoxification therapy under the general supervision of a licensed acupuncturist or physician. Under current law, a licensed acupuncturist or physician must directly supervise auricular detoxification therapy. This bill does not create additional requirements or duties for the Board of Medical Examiners. Therefore, this bill will have no impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
