### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill will have no expenditure impact to the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds, as the revisions in the bill are not expected to fiscally or materially alter the Department of Revenue's responsibilities.

## **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

### **State Expenditure**

This bill limits retail dealer licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor to three retail dealer licenses per one licensee. Retail dealer licenses for alcoholic liquors are distributed by the Department of Revenue (DOR). In addition, the bill allows a licensee to purchase alcoholic liquor for sale by the drink from a licensed wholesaler. The guidelines for deliveries from licensed wholesalers are outlined. DOR indicates that the bill will not materially or fiscally impact the department, as retail dealer licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor are currently administered by DOR and are limited to three per one licensee. As such, this bill will have no expenditure impact to the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
