**Introduced on January 11, 2018**

**State Expenditure**

This bill requires that the video presentation made available to new parents, childcare providers and facilities, and any interested individual include safe sleep practices and the causes of Sudden Unexpected Infant Death Syndrome (SUIDS). Current requirements for these videos are that they include the dangers associated with shaking infants and young children. DHEC currently approves and provides these videos at department cost. DHEC must also update the protocol for health care providers to include educating parents or primary caregivers about safe sleep practices and SUIDS. Currently, the protocol only includes dangers associated with shaking infants and young children.

DHEC is currently developing an updated version of their video concerning the dangers of shaking infants and young children. DHEC is using this opportunity to include educational information about safe sleep recommendations and SUIDS. Related expenses for this video will be funded by the Federal Maternal and Child Health Title V Block Grant. Because expenses associated with the requirements of this bill have already been accounted for, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, and Other Funds.
