#### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill would have an undetermined expenditure impact on the General Fund as the salaries for constitutional officers would be at the discretion of the General Assembly. This bill would have no impact to Other Funds or Federal Funds.

## **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

#### Introduced on March 15, 2018 State Expenditure

This bill requires the General Assembly to provide for the salaries of the following state officials: Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Attorney General, Comptroller General, Superintendent of Education, Adjutant General, and Commissioner of Agriculture. The General Assembly would be required to set the salaries in the general appropriations every four years to last for the duration of each official's term beginning with the 2018 general appropriations. This would allow the salaries to be set for the 2018 election cycle, per the effective date of this bill. The expenditure impact of this bill is undetermined, beginning in FY 2018-19, as the General Assembly has the discretion to determine the amount of each salary.
