#### Introduced on March 20, 2019 **State Expenditure**

This bill makes changes to the Nurse Practice Act by providing that Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRN) may perform specified medical acts pursuant to their approved written guidelines. In addition, it removes the requirement that Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists must be supervised when practicing in accordance with their approved written guidelines.
