Fiscal Impact Summary

This joint resolution will have no expenditure impact as the members of the newly established committee may not receive mileage, subsistence, or per diem, and staffing for the committee can be managed within existing appropriations.

State Expenditure

This joint resolution creates a committee to study certain issues affecting veterans. The six-member committee will consist of three members of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate and three members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House. The committee must present a report to both houses of the General Assembly and to the Governor no later than January 31, 2021, at which time the committee will dissolve. The committee members may not receive mileage, per diem, or subsistence. Additionally, the staffing for this committee will be provided by the General Assembly and will be managed with existing staff and within existing appropriations. Therefore, this joint resolution will not have an expenditure impact for the Senate or the House of Representatives.
