Fiscal Impact Summary

State Expenditure

The bill clarifies the definition of capitol grounds as the area inward from the driving surfaces of Gervais, Sumter, Pendleton, and Assembly Streets in the city of Columbia. Prior definitions describe capitol grounds as the area inward from Gervais, Sumter, Senate, and Assembly Streets.

Department of Administration. The department indicates that the bill will not result in additional expenditures, as the area inward from Gervais, Sumter, Pendleton, and Assembly Streets is already considered capitol grounds. As such, the bill has no impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds for the Department of Administration.

Department of Public Safety. The department indicates this bill will have no fiscal impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds as the bill does not alter department's patrol area.
