### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill requires the State Law Enforcement Division (SLED) to disburse \$250,000 of appropriated funds to the South Carolina State Firefighters Association for the reimbursement to firefighters and emergency medical technicians who incur out-of-pocket expenses for mental injury as a result of a critical incident during the scope of their employment.

#### **Introduced on January 8, 2019**

##### **State Expenditure**

This bill requires SLED to disburse \$250,000 of appropriated funds to the South Carolina State Firefighters Association for the reimbursement to firefighters and emergency medical technicians who incur out-of-pocket expenses for mental injury as a result of a critical incident during the scope of their employment. SLED will receive a total of \$51,288,539 in General Fund appropriations pursuant to Act 264 of 2018.
