This bill will have no expenditure impact on local school districts since districts currently notify law enforcement upon notice that a person is engaging in activities that may result in injury or threat of injury at any school event. Additionally, districts currently notify the parent or guardian of a student who engages in or is the victim of such incidents at any school event.

Local Expenditure

This bill requires school administrators to contact law enforcement authorities immediately upon notice that a person is engaging in or has engaged in activities at a school-sanctioned or school-sponsored activity that may result in injury or serious threat of injury. Currently, school administrators must notify law enforcement when such activities occur on school property. Also, this bill requires school administrators to immediately notify the parent or guardian of a student who engages in or is a victim of such activities.

The State Department of Education indicates that this bill will have no expenditure impact on local school districts. Districts currently notify law enforcement when these types of incidents occur at any school event. Additionally, districts currently notify the parent or guardian of students who engage in or are victims of an injury or serious threat of injury while at any school event.
