This bill prohibits a member of the General Assembly from using official funds for unsolicited mass communication or official letterhead within ninety days of any election in which the member's name or advisory referendum is on the ballot and will have no fiscal impact on the Senate or the House of Representatives because it does not operationally impact the legislative bodies.
