Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will have no revenue impact to the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds as it permits redevelopment authorities (RA's) to use redevelopment fees on museum projects.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on March 5, 2020 State Expenditure N/A

State Revenue

This bill expands the powers available to RA's to permit them to use redevelopment fees for the financing, acquiring, developing, supporting, and operating of museum projects. Currently, RA's receive redevelopment fees equal to five percent of all in-state wages paid to employees by a federal employer at a closed or realigned federal installation. RA's are permitted to use redevelopment fees on projects designed to either reduce unemployment or increase the property tax base in their assigned redevelopment project area.

This bill will permit the RA's to use redevelopment fees for museum projects, but will not change the amount of redevelopment fees available to the RA's. Therefore, this bill will not have a fiscal impact to state revenues.
