## **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Social Services DSS because it does not alter their current responsibilities regarding the regulation of childcare facilities.

## **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

## Introduced on February 23, 2021 State Expenditure

This bill amends the composition of the State Advisory Committee on the Regulation of Childcare Facilities, which is responsible for advising the Department of Social Services (DSS) regarding regulations on childcare facilities. Currently, the Advisory Committee consists of seventeen members, with one member required to be the operator of a church-operated childcare center, and another to be the parent of a child receiving childcare services at a church-operated childcare center. The provisions of this bill would make it so these two members may represent a registered faith-based childcare facility in addition to a registered church-operated childcare facility. DSS indicates this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the agency as it does not alter their current responsibilities.
