## Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will have no fiscal impact on the Department of Administration because the agency can accomplish the identification of a location on the State House grounds for presidential internment using existing resources.

## Explanation of Fiscal Impact

## Introduced on March 2, 2021 <br> State Expenditure

This bill requires that the Department of Administration (DOA) offer any twice-acquitted President of the United States the honor of being buried on the State House grounds. Upon acceptance of the honor by the President and approval by the State House Committee, DOA must identify a location on the State House grounds for the internment and erection of a tombstone and grave marker. Federal legislation that forbids the internment or inurnment of such presidents in Arlington National Cemetery must be enacted for this bill to take effect. This bill will have no fiscal impact on DOA as it can accomplish the requirements of the bill using existing resources.
