Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill, as amended, allows an applicant for a driver's license, beginner's permit, or identification card to use a name on the card that is different from their birth name with appropriate documentation. The amended bill also allows an applicant to prove the validity of his Social Security number electronically, as long as the documentation does not conflict with other provisions of State or federal law. The bill will have no impact on General Fund expenditures of the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) because the agency can manage any expenses for training and updating forms within existing appropriations.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Amended by House Education and Public Works on February 22, 2022 **State Expenditure**

This bill, as amended, allows an applicant for a driver's license, beginner's permit, or identification card to use a name on the card that is different from their birth name with appropriate documentation. Appropriate documentation is described as at least three different documents that show the applicant's full name with the preferred name being the one used for at least fifteen years. The amended bill also allows an applicant to prove the validity of his Social Security number electronically, as long as the documentation does not conflict with other provisions of State or federal law. DMV indicates that expenses for training and updating forms and procedures will be minimal and can be managed within existing appropriations. Therefore, there is no expenditure impact on DMV.
