This bill requires the Law Enforcement Training Council (LETC) to adopt a model training program for newly appointed chiefs of police. This this bill does not have an expenditure impact, because the department anticipates being able to perform activities in the normal course of agency business.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on January 12, 2021 State Expenditure

This bill requires the Law Enforcement Training Council (LETC) to adopt a model training program for newly appointed chiefs of police. The LETC must review the program every three years and adopt revisions as necessary. Any person appointed as the chief of police will be required to complete the training program. This provision does not apply to duly elected sheriffs. The bill requires the department to perform activities that will be conducted in the normal course of agency business. As a result, this bill does not have an expenditure impact.
