Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill prevents an employer from taking an adverse employment action against an employee who chooses not to undergo a COVID-19 vaccination, with the exception of an employee or contractor working for an entity that is treating or caring for vulnerable populations. Additionally, DHEC cannot require isolation or quarantine for a person who chooses not to undergo the vaccine. The bill will not impact expenditures of the Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) because the agency is currently complying with the provisions of the bill. There will also be no impact on expenditures of the Department of Administration (DOA) because it does not materially impact the operations of the agency.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Amended by the Senate on April 8, 2021 **State Expenditure**

This bill prevents an employer from taking an adverse employment action against an employee who chooses not to undergo a COVID-19 vaccination, with the exception of an employee or contractor working for an entity that is treating or caring for vulnerable populations.
