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### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill amends Section 1-11-720, which lists the employers whose employees are eligible for the State Health Plan and State Dental Insurance Plan, to include school board members.

The fiscal impact of this bill on Public Employee Benefit Authority (PEBA) is pending, contingent upon an additional response from PEBA.

In addition, local expenditures on school boards is pending contingent upon further analysis by PEBA.

### **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

#### **Introduced on March 9, 2023**

##### **State Expenditure**

This bill amends Section 1-11-720, which lists the employers allowed to offer the State Health Plan and State Dental Insurance Plan, to include school board members. These plans are currently offered to state employees and retirees, political subdivisions and their agencies, and many other employers, including the South Carolina School Boards Association, South Carolina Teachers' Association, and the South Carolina Education Association. This bill adds school board members to the list of employers whose employees are eligible for the State Health Plan and State Dental Insurance Plan. The State Health Plan and the State Dental Insurance Plan have both employer and employee contributions.

PEBA administers these state health plans. The expenditure impact of this bill on PEBA is pending, contingent upon a response.
