Additionally, this bill specifies that the Department of Social Services (DSS) must provide consent for adoption when a child is voluntarily left with a safe haven or was otherwise abandoned. Lastly, this bill adds the parents of an infant who was left at a safe haven and the parents of a child who was otherwise abandoned to the list of persons not required to give consent or relinquishment for adoption.
