## **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill exempts certain personal identifying information of lottery prize winners from requirements under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) and prohibits disclosure of the information by the SC Lottery Commission (commission), its contractors, or other governmental entities in response to a FOIA request without express written consent from the winner or for any purpose required by law.

This bill will have no expenditure impact on the Lottery Commission as the provisions of this bill can be managed under the commission's normal operations.

## **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

## **Introduced on February 2, 2023 State Expenditure**

This bill exempts certain personal identifying information of lottery prize winners from requirements under FOIA and may not be disclosed by the commission in response to a FOIA request without express written consent from the winner. The bill also prohibits the commission, its contractors, or other governmental entities with whom lottery prize winner information is shared from disseminating this information to a third party without consent from the winner or for any other purpose as required by law. The bill makes further conforming changes to code related to the disclosure of personal information of lottery winners.

The commission indicates that exempting the personal information of lottery prize winners from FOIA requirements or requests can be managed under normal operations. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the Lottery Commission.
