This applies only if the policy or endorsement does not contain personally identifying information. This bill also outlines certain guidelines the insurer must follow if the policy is posted online to ensure the insured has easy and convenient access to the policy or endorsement.

This bill will have no expenditure impact for the Department of Insurance (DOI) as the agency anticipates being able to manage any additional responsibilities with existing staff and within existing appropriations.
